### 1. Champagne, Cuvée Royale Brut

The aromas are fine, delicate and complex,  
Notes of apple and peach.  
Fresh attack, lots of life and is yet supple  
round and most refreshing on the finish.  
Elegant, fresh, light, well-balanced with good length

### 2. Champagne Cuvée Royale Brut Rose

Shows both red and black fruits.  
There are notes of wild violet followed by a touch of liquorice.  
Ripeness and breeding with hints of sweet red fruits.  
Energy and elegance, long finish with just a touch of menthol

<b>10. Schmitt Sohne Piesporter Michelsberg</b> A clean, fresh, medium-dry with light grapey fruit flavours	<b>Germany</b>	<b>16.25</b>
<b>11. Boars Kloof, Chenin Blanc- Riebeek Cellars Swartland</b> Crisp and dry with a delicate lemon colour, displaying intense floral, guava and citrus aromas and succulent tropical fruit on the palate.	<b>South Africa</b>	<b>17.25</b>
<b>12. Pinot Grigio, Cardone-IGT Veneto</b> Elegant and delicate perfume and fresh apple fruit whilst matching subtle peach and pear flavours.	<b>Italy</b>	<b>18.95</b>
<b>15. Trebbiano d'Abruzzo 2014/15</b> Pale yellow colour, it has a delicate nose, with hints of white flowers, and unripe fruit It goes well with appetizers, main dishes, seafood, soups and white meats.	<b>Italy</b>	<b>18.95</b>
<b>16. Sauvignon Blanc, Holmes Point – Marlborough</b> This is a classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, which means plenty of crisp fruit with hints of grapefruit and fresh cut herbs in a clean, fresh - tasting package with lots of zip. Perfectly balanced and not too tart	<b>New Zealand</b>	<b>22.50</b>
<b>17. Petit Chablis Domaine de la Motte</b> A classic Chablis from vines grown on the famous Kimmeridgian clay with nervy, mineral fruit but added depth from a small, round 10%, addition of some oak aged wine into the blend. This is very typical of the Motte style and gives a richness and balance to the wine.	<b>France</b>	<b>25.50</b>
<b>18. Sancerre, 'Domaine du Pre Semele, Loire</b> A Classic Sancerre with ripe gooseberry fruit and zesty acidity. The style is full and round yet fresh and well-balanced.	<b>France</b>	<b>28.95</b>

## Red Wines

<b>19. Malbec, Alto de Mayo – Mendoza</b> This fruit-packed Argentine Malbec is full of juicy cherries and plum flavours. This is a smooth and rounded easy-drinking red with notes of blackcurrant and violets on the finish.	<b>Argentina</b>	<b>21.95</b> <b>13.85 ½ Carafe</b>
<b>20. False Bay Pinotage - Waterkloof</b> Perfect Pinotage. Bright, vibrant and juicy. Deep garnet colour. On the nose there are hints of dark fruits, chocolate and Eucalyptus leading to a heady mix of fruit, rich chocolate and plums supported by soft tannins	<b>South Africa</b>	<b>19.25</b>
<b>21. Cabernet Sauvignon Karu</b> Youthful and vibrant, with strawberry and cherry fruit aromas and a twist of vanilla. The very gentle tannic structure supports an abundant spice and cassis fruit core finishing with an excellent weight of flavour	<b>Chile</b>	<b>18.50</b>
<b>22. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo 2013</b> Bold Montepulciano with fruit as thundering as a church organ being walloped by a demented orang-utan, yet nowhere near as vulgar. Plum-skin fruit allied to leathery warmth with all-over chocolate finish.	<b>Italy</b>	<b>19.95</b>

<b>23. Bordeaux Superieur, Chateau Pontet Nivelle</b>	<b>Bordeaux</b>	<b>24.25</b>
A great all-rounder Claret tasting like it should with bramble berry fruit and soft silky tannins. Vastly underrated good drinking Bordeaux red wine.		
<b>24. Fleurie La Reine de l'Arinite</b>	<b>Beaujolais</b>	<b>25.50</b>
A heady perfume of freshly picked irises and peonies drift above the crushed berry fruit nose. Ripe tannins and fresh acidity support a palate of Morello cherries and bitter dark chocolate (reminiscent of Black Forest Gateaux).		
<b>25. Adobe Reserva (ORGANIC) Pinot Noir</b>	<b>Chile</b>	<b>22.50</b>
Light ruby red in colour with aromas of fresh strawberries accompanied by subtle notes of spices and a touch of minerality. The medium bodied palate is elegant, delicate and fresh with ripe tannins and a long finish.		
<b>26. Côtes du Rhône Villages, Les Coteaux, Boutinot</b>	<b>Rhone</b>	<b>23.95</b>
Elegant berry fruit aromas backed with a hint of cedar and spice, soft supple tannins marrying into the cherry fruit flavours result in a wine that is rich and smooth		
<b>27. Lussac St Emilion, Le Cadet du Claymore</b>	<b>Bordeaux</b>	<b>29.95</b>
The second label of the prestigious Chateau de la Claymore. Good claret to shout about with a firm body and grip, and showing some very nice deep fruit character on the nose and palate		
<b>28. Rioja Reserva Letargo – Bodegas D. Mateos</b>	<b>Spain</b>	<b>26.75</b>
Brilliant ruby-red colour with light brick red tones. Very complex aromas of ageing over a persistent background of liquorice and composted black fruit (prunes and dried figs). Structured and smooth wine with a Velvety end reminiscent of ageing.

<b>30. Chardonnay Rye Mill</b> <b>South East Australia</b> Brilliant pale straw in colour with lifted fresh citrus melon fruits on the nose. Nice balance of fruit sweetness on the palate consisting of smooth soft peachy melon fruit, with clean acid astringency on the palate.	<b>3.85</b>	<b>4.95</b>	<b>6.35</b>	<b>11.98</b>	<b>17.95</b>
