



As we see a relaxation in national restrictions and we welcome you to our hotel, your continued Health and Safety continues to be of the utmost priority to us.

We have made changes with the hotel in response to the Covid-19 Pandemic and the following measures will continue to be in place for the immediate future.

Additionally, we will constantly review the information and advice issued by the Government and will make any changes to our procedures accordingly.

- Hand Sanitization points are provided around the building and guests are encouraged to make use of them.
- Whilst no longer mandatory we strongly recommend that guests wear a mask when moving around public areas of the hotel.
- Guests choosing to go to the Breakfast Buffet for cold items will be asked to wear a mask and to sanitize their hands.
- Guests dining at our Sunday Carvery will also be asked to wear a mask and sanitize their hands when they go to the carvery unit.
- Additional cleaning and sanitizing measures already introduced will be continued.
- It is still politely requested that hotel guests use the toilet facilities in their rooms rather than the public toilets.
- A pre-registration form will still be sent prior to your arrival allowing you to complete your details and spend as little time checking in as possible.
- Guests rooms will now be serviced daily unless it is requested by the guest that Housekeep do not go into their room.
- Although more Restaurant tables have been returned, we have not moved back to full capacity.
- Air conditioning is in use whenever the Restaurant is open.
- Laminated menus continue to be in use, sanitized after each time they are used.
- Bar service is now available, but guests will be discouraged from drinking at the bar as it is a small area and also a walkway to the Commodores Suite.
- Table service for drinks will continue to be provided for the Lounge, Restaurant and Terraces.
