1. Champagne, Cuvée Royale Brut

Balanced, elegant and light. The nose is delicate, fine and complex. Notes of green apple and vine peach bring a fruity touch. Nice roundness on the palate, long and refreshing finish.

2. Champagne Cuvée Royale Brut Rose

Shows both red and black fruits. There are notes of wild violet followed by a touch of liquorice. Ripeness and breeding with hints of sweet, red fruits. Energy and elegance, long finish with just a touch of menthol.

5. Champagne Bollinger

A powerful yet elegant, bone-dry champagne with a high proportion of Pinot Noir giving a wonderfully biscuity nose, and flavours of citrus, nuts, figs and spice.

7. Lunetta Prosecco Rose – Veneto Italy

Fresh berry aromas and a fine mousse lead to Redcurrent and citrus notes on the palate, Balanced by bright acidity and a clean, dry finish.

8. Lunetta Prosecco Spumante NV - Cavit Veneto Italy

Deliciously light and fruity Prosecco with hints of apple and peach on the nose and a fresh, softly sparkling palate with characters of soft, ripe stone fruits.

9. Nozeco Alcohol Free Sparkling White Wine - Italy

On the nose, it seduces us with its bouquet of very intense fruity aromas. On the palate, this wine is very well balanced and offers us a good structure and finish.

10. Roger Goulart Brut Reseva Cava

Long ageing cava of strong character from its ageing on lees. Yellow Colour with golden reflections, Bright with fine bubbles, on the nose it is creamy, highlighting the fruity notes with a background of toasted nuts. Fresh palate, silky and structured.

11. Kraal Bay, Chenin Blanc - Swartland South Africa

The nose and palate has an abundance of tropical fruits balanced by a crisp acidity.

14. Casa De Vila Nova Vinho Verde – Vinho Verde Portugal

Floral, citrus and gentle tropical aromas lead on to a palate with sherbet lemon acidity, a touch of mango and a bright mineral finish.

16. Allan Scott - Marlborough, Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand

A fragrant mix of pineapple and passionfruit tropical flavours with underlying zesty citrus characters of orange and lime.




17. Chablis Domaine de la Motte – France

35.00



A fuller style of Petit Chablis with a flinty dry and powerful body and “Petit” in name only. Soft, voluptuous fruit is matched by fascinating mineral properties. A long-lasting palate that is delicious and memorable.

Red Wines

- 20. False Bay Pinotage – Waterkloof – South Africa** 26.50 
Perfect Pinotage. Bright, vibrant and juicy. Deep garnet colour. On the nose there are hints of dark fruits, chocolate and eucalyptus leading to a heady mix of fruit, rich chocolate and plums supported by soft tannins.
- 21. Oude Kaap Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon - South Africa** 24.00
A medium bodied red wine displaying juicy blackcurrant flavours and tobacco spice aromas allowing immediate accessibility.
- 24. Fleurie La Riene De L'Arenite Madone - France** 32.50
Pretty, floral, elegant and aromatic. Spot on Fleurie!
- 25. Adobe Reserva (ORGANIC) Pinot Noir - Chile** 28.00 
Light ruby red in colour with aromas of fresh strawberries accompanied by subtle notes of spices and a touch of minerality. The medium bodied palate is elegant, delicate and fresh with ripe tannins and a long finish.
- 26. Boutinot 'Les Coteaux' Côtes du Rhône Villages - France** 27.95 
Immediately impressive, this wine reveals its class from the start. Brambly fruit underpinned by subtle oaky nuances, lovely sweet spice – warm star anise with a touch of cinnamon.
- 27. Château La Pointe Bouquey-St Emilion - France** 33.00
A Merlot dominant wine with a warm spiced bread, red fruit character and vanilla oak on finish.
- 28. Letargo. Rioja Reserva - Spain** 33.00
With aromas of liquorice, black fruit, prunes and dried figs. Complex spices and mineral aromas at the end. A smooth wine with a velvety finish.
